Since 2023, through our Edelweiss 2030 plan, MMV has chosen to take a slightly different trail. One that leads to a more regenerative, clear-headed and collective way of experiencing the mountains. It is thanks to the energy of our teams, the trust of our guests and the loyalty of our partners that MMV can continue to move forward.

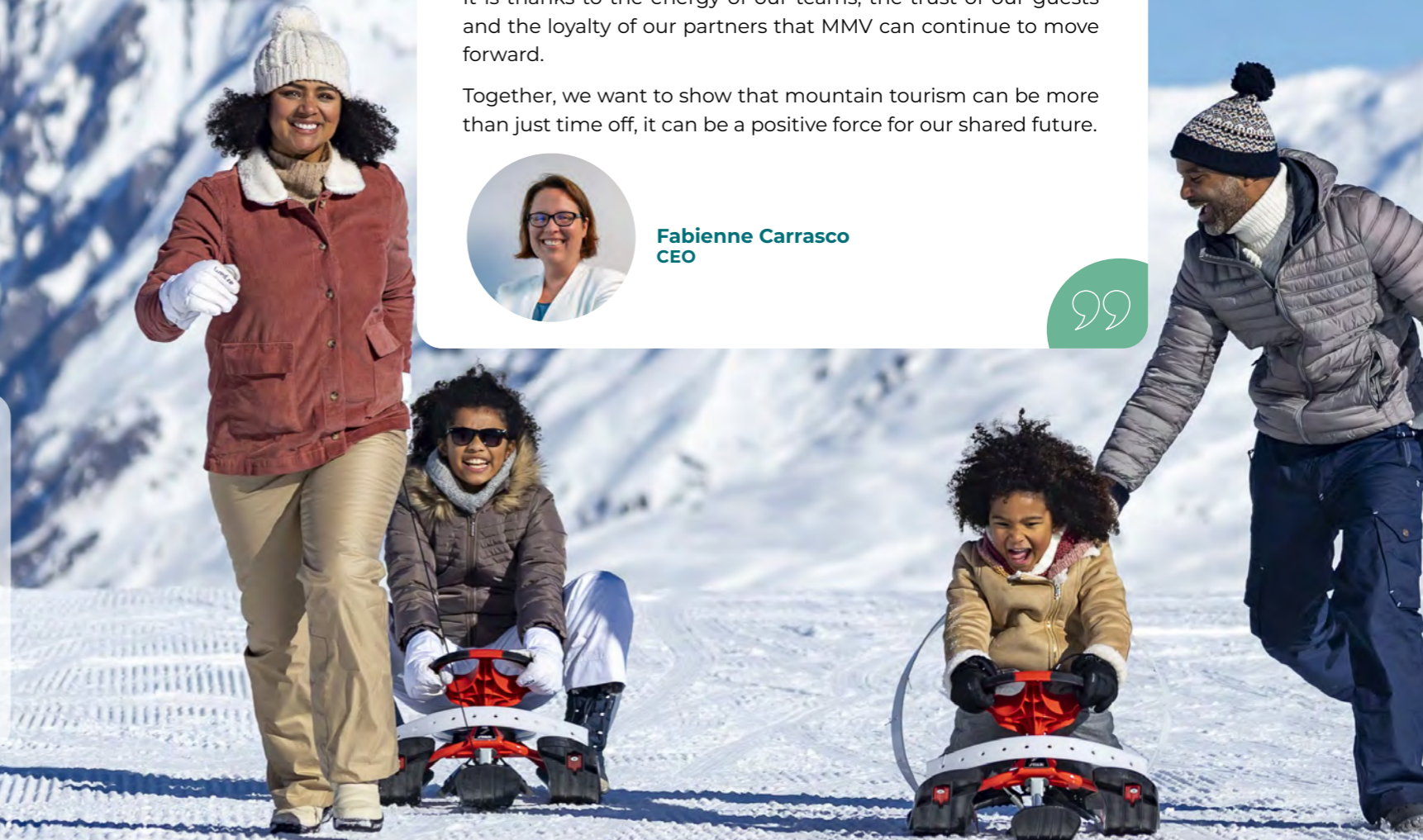

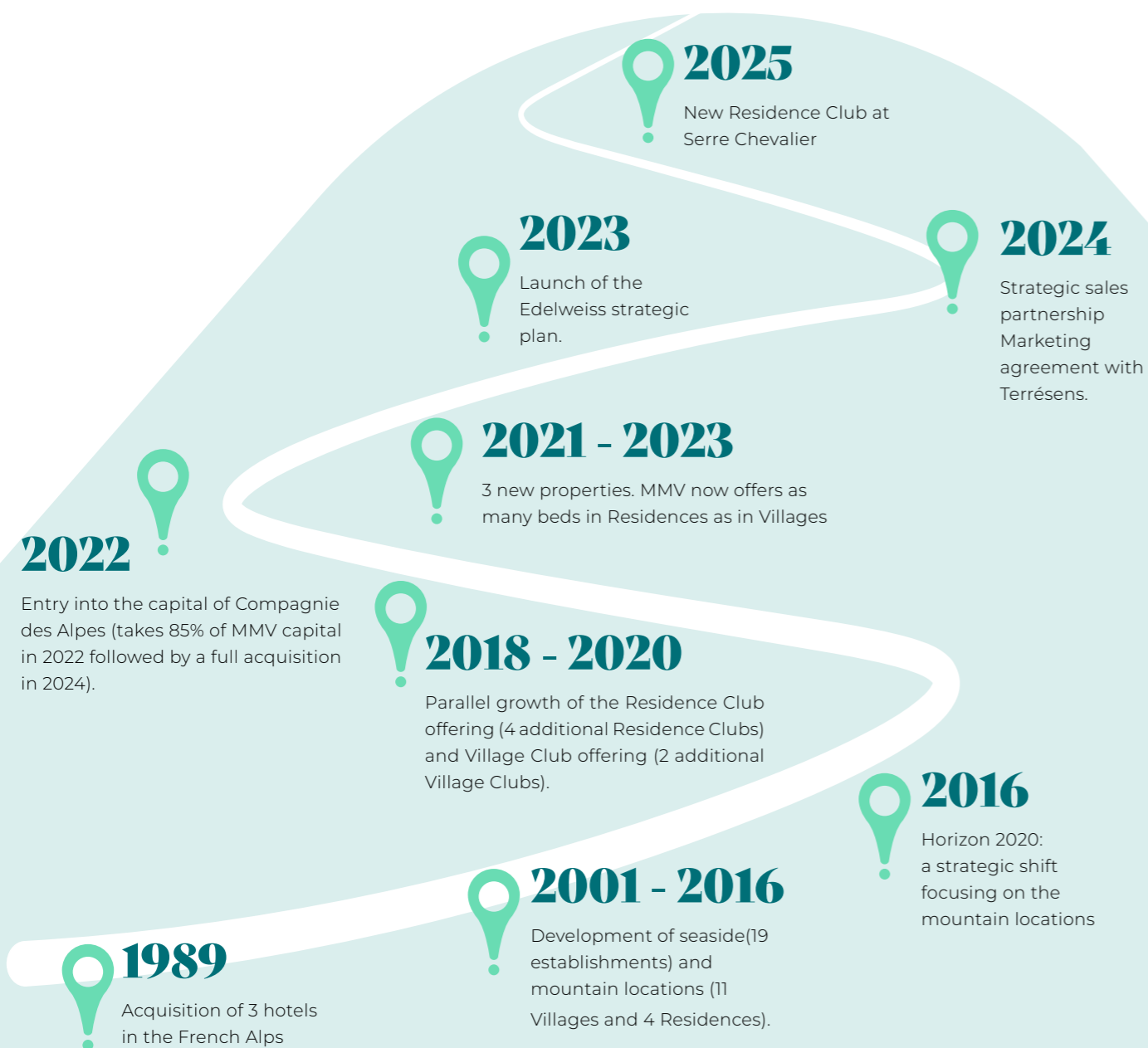
35 YEARS OF HISTORY AT THE HEART OF THE ALPS

For nearly 35 years, MMV has been shaping the art of club-style mountain holidays.

The adventure began in 1989 with the take-over of three hotels in the Alps. From the very start, MMV's DNA was clear: welcoming holiday resorts generous dining, accommodation designed for families and groups, kids' clubs, and entertainment that brings people together. Over the years, the brand continued to grow and innovate, giving birth to the Residence Club concept: apartment rentals that combine freedom and comfort with kids' clubs and entertainment, blending the best of holiday clubs with the standards of serviced residences.

In October 2022, MMV joined La Compagnie des Alpes, strengthening its position among the leading hospitality operators in the French Alps.

Today, MMV operates 10 Villages Clubs and 11 Résidences Clubs, offering an original model combining the warmth of holiday clubs and the quality standards of home rentals - always with the same promise: holidays designed to be shared. of holiday clubs with the standards of hotel residences.

Since 2023, MMV has been moving forward with “Edelweiss 2030”, an ambitious transformation plan rooted in environmental responsibility, social innovation, and strong local ties. Our aim is clear: to make MMV an inspiring, committed, and exemplary company both today and for the years to come..

We are fully aware of the environmental emergency we face, as well as the complex economic and socio-cultural challenges specific to mountain regions. That is why in 2024, we joined the Convention des Entreprises pour le Climat (CEC), a collective journey designed to help business leaders rethink their models and accelerate meaningful transformation.

Our guiding principle is simple: “Living better together.”

In concrete terms, this means reducing the negative impacts of our operations, from carbon emissions to water and energy use, with the ambition of reaching Net Zero Carbon on scopes 1 and 2 by 2030. It also means protecting biodiversity, raising awareness and engaging awareness and engage both our teams and guests, and strengthening our long-term commitment to the Alpine territories that inspire us every day..

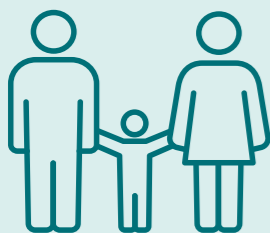

Behind the scenes: a committed team

- Taking part in No Finish Line Nice, a solidarity race supporting disadvantaged or sick children



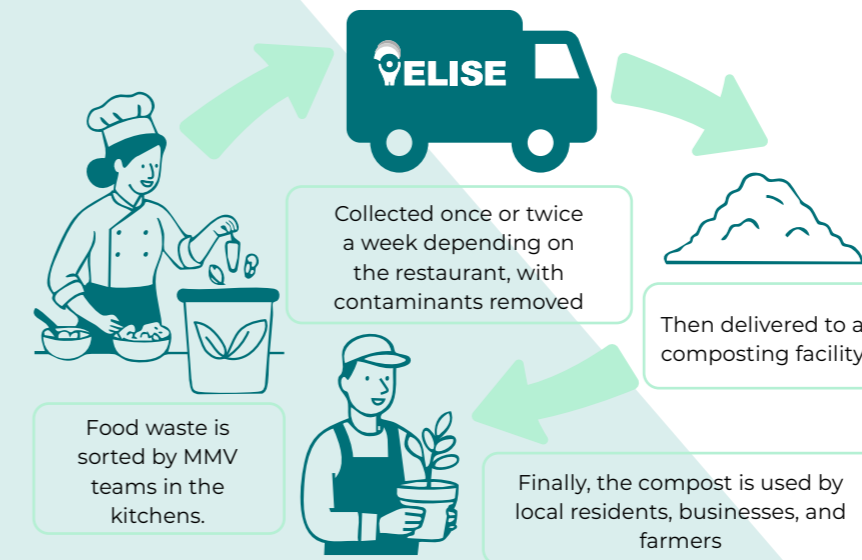
And what about our guests?

Our Villages Clubs offer guided hikes: a great way to explore local landscapes and discover mountain biodiversity alongside passionate guides. In winter, the same spirit continues with snowshoe outings, inviting guests to experience the mountains at a gentler pace. When showcasing local activities, MMV deliberately avoids high-impact options such as snowmobiling. Instead, we highlight low-impact alternatives through carefully curated guides, with a special focus on sustainable, family- and child-friendly experiences. “MMV has a real role to play as a host in these exceptional environments,” explains Romain Fonteneau, CSR Manager at MMV. “The goal is to build a responsible guest experience by explaining, in a positive and accessible way, how everyone can reduce their impact. By 2050, each person should emit no more than two tonnes of carbon per year. What does that mean for tourist accommodation? And how can our resorts operate within planetary limits? These are key questions guiding our development strategy.”



In the bins

For organic waste management, MMV collaborates with Elise Alpes in Grenoble, an organization that combines environmental protection with the creation of inclusive jobs for people with disabilities.



The group also implements other initiatives: elimination of single-use packaging, reduction of food waste, displaying waste-sorting guides on bins, and providing bio-buckets in every apartment of the Residences.

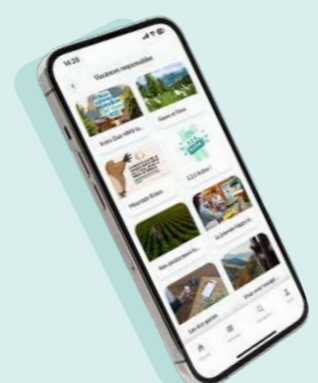

In our guests' pocket

The MMV app supports guests at every stage of their stay. It includes a dedicated section showcasing MMV’s commitments, with practical tools and inspiration: eco-friendly everyday actions, our environmental charter, Tictac Trip, and a simple waste-sorting guide. The app also highlights local experiences and low-impact mobility options, with a dedicated tab focused on biodiversity and discovery, from hiking trails and bike rentals to shuttle services, making it easier for guests to explore the mountains responsibly, one choice at a time.



This winter, we go even further

- ✓ As a winner of a water management project call (AMI), we are testing concrete solutions across several pilot sites.
- ✓ We are continuously adapting our offering - experimenting with low-energy relaxation spaces, rolling out water recovery systems, and opening sites off-season to local communities.
- ✓ At the same time, we are strengthening our support for local producers and artisans in our valleys. This winter, our goal is to source 40% of our food purchases through short supply chains, while also providing guidance to partners transitioning towards organic practices.
- ✓ Finally, we are choosing renovation over artificialisation, a demanding path, but an essential one.

From Animation to Management: Benoît Allays' Journey

At just 18, Benoît Allays took his first steps at MMV as a trainee entertainer. Today, at 29, he manages the Village Club of Flaine — a decade-long professional journey with MMV.

«Animation was my entry point: it allowed me to discover the world of MMV villages and clubs. Soon, I wanted to move into accommodation. After a season as a receptionist, I took part in an internal training program to become Head Receptionist, then Accommodation Manager for three years. I used the off-seasons to explore other roles, this time in food & beverage, as a waiter or floor manager. My goal was to become an accountant manager, with the ultimate aim of directing a village. Every time I requested training, it was heard and supported. That's true MMV spirit: all the managers I met encouraged me to move forward.»

Today, Benoît has not only reached his goal but also mentors others:

«I trained a floor manager who became my assistant director... That's also the MMV spirit: grow and share.»

3 questions for Christelle Mercieri

Human Resources Director at MMV

Welcoming seasonal teams: a key challenge, season after season Welcoming seasonal staff is a major challenge every winter. How do you approach this, from recruitment to the start of the season?

“At MMV, we launched a flagship initiative dedicated to seasonal staff onboarding. Once a recruitment is confirmed, we stay in close contact with each future team member one to two months before their arrival. They receive all the practical information they need — about MMV, their assigned site, accommodation, uniforms and daily life on site. This early connection reassures new recruits and significantly reduces last-minute dropouts. The onboarding continues after arrival, for up to two months on site. After a successful trial at two locations last winter, the programme was rolled out across all our sites this summer, with very positive feedback from managers.

Accommodation and training are also strong markers of MMV's HR policy, aren't they?

Absolutely. These are two pillars of our approach. All our seasonal staff are accommodated — either individually or in shared apartments — for a symbolic financial contribution, while MMV makes a substantial investment in the quality of housing. This is a key driver of loyalty. Training is equally essential. Each year, we support around one hundred apprentices through our partner schools, across many professions: bar, entertainment, kitchen, spa, reception and more. We also run a Best Talent programme to strengthen key skills such as management and digital tools, open to both permanent and seasonal staff. It's a way to recognise every career path and encourage people to grow with us.

What early results are you seeing in terms of retention?

The pre-season 'campus', organised two weeks before Christmas, has become a cornerstone of our system. Over around ten days, department heads and apprentices are trained in our processes and guest experience standards, which they can then pass on to their teams more effectively. The results speak for themselves: last January, the dropout rate — seasonal staff leaving after the season had started — fell by three points compared to the previous winter. Even more encouraging, our loyalty rate is rising. Nearly one third of our workforce had already worked with MMV the previous winter, up seven points year-on-year and twelve points over two years. Some team members now complete four or five consecutive seasons with us. This trust is the strongest validation of our HR policy, particularly around accommodation and training.”



“Helping Hand”: an employee support program

The “Helping Hand” program is a toll-free hotline funded by MMV. This service is free for employees and anonymous, allowing them to speak with professionals about personal or work-related issues, such as financial difficulties, team conflicts, separation, or bereavement.

Brand-New Résidence Club in Serre-Chevalier

Opening in December 2025, the new Résidence Club in Serre-Chevalier welcomes guests into a thoughtfully designed setting, with 170 apartments for 2 to 8 people, ideal for holidays shared with family or friends.

Designed for comfort and conviviality, the residence features a central lively bar, kids' clubs from age 4, and a wellness area. Created around comfort and togetherness, the residence features a lively central bar, kids' clubs from age 4, and a wellness area complete with spa, outdoor pool and sun-filled terrace. Just two minutes from the slopes of the largest ski area in the Southern Alps, thanks to an electric shuttle service, it combines everyday convenience: parking, bakery and breakfast service with a strong environmental commitment. For this latest project, MMV has gone even further: green roofs, solar panels, wood-fired heating systems and intelligent building management all contribute to a more responsible approach to mountain hospitality. A cosy and forward-looking new address in the heart of the Alps, ready to be discovered this winter. Residence highlights a welcoming lobby lounge with fireplace and bar, contemporary décor, an aquatic wellness area, bakery and breakfast service, support for children's ski lessons, an on-site ski shop and dedicated ski room.



Val Thorens Restaurant Gets a Makeover

In Val Thorens, the Les Arolles restaurant unveils a new décor this winter, reinforcing its Alpine roots and the group's identity. Without changing the layout or organization of the space, the redesign focuses on a mountain atmosphere: more wood, authentic objects, and Alpine photography. The contemporary chalet spirit is enhanced with careful attention to material choices and highlighting the surrounding territory. Local sourcing remains at the heart of the experience, with partner producers now highlighted through short videos. This refresh completes last year's renovation of the reception and lounge areas, offering a cohesive and welcoming setting.

Stay Connected with bump

MMV has partnered with BUMP, a specialist in electric vehicle charging solutions, to make mountain stays easier for EV drivers. With the installation of state-of-the-art charging stations at several of our Résidences and Villages Clubs, traveling by electric car has never been simpler. The participating locations include Risoul, Arêches-Beaufort, La Plagne Aime 2000, Belle Plagne, Arc 2000, Tignes 1800, Les 2 Alpes (Les Clarines), Le Corbier, Samoëns, and Serre Chevalier. This winter, there will be over 40 AC charging points available for guests. No more hunting for an available station in the resort — the chargers are conveniently located in MMV car parks.



The Return of the Night Train

For the 2025–2026 winter season, La Compagnie des Alpes is bringing back the Paris – Bourg-Saint-Maurice night train. Developed by the subsidiary Travelski, this service aims to reduce the carbon footprint of travel to Alpine resorts, one of La Compagnie des Alpes' environmental commitments. With 660 berths and a bar car, the service will operate 14 round trips between December 2025 and March 2026, stopping at Moûtiers, Aime-La Plagne, and Bourg-Saint-Maurice, with onward transfers to the ski resorts. Marketed by MMV, this all-in-one travel option includes breakfast on arrival and a free day of skiing. Departures are on Friday evenings, with arrivals Saturday morning, allowing guests to enjoy a full 8 days of skiing. Comfortable, practical and more responsible, the night train offers a relaxed way to begin a ski holiday: no traffic, no fatigue, just the mountains ahead.

The extra that makes a difference:

Guests who choose the bus, train or carpooling instead of driving alone receive a gift voucher for their next stay!



Wellness Program: Breathe Easy

MMV wellness program takes a deep breath... and gains some altitude! Already popular in Samoëns, Arêches-Beaufort, and Sainte-Foy, it is now expanding Serre Chevalier with the opening of the new residence.

Yoga, sophrology, stretching, and other relaxing moments are offered free of charge, giving a chance to unwind, refocus, and savor the moment, right in the heart of the mountains. A true breath of fresh air within the MMV Résidences Clubs activity program.

5 Questions for Sylvie Joly, Deputy CEO in Charge of Commerce, Marketing, and Digital

What are MMV's priorities for the coming winter season?

Guest satisfaction remains our guiding star. To deliver it, we focus on three key levers: digital innovation, the development of direct sales and the continuous improvement of the on-site experience. Our ambition is to make holidays smoother, more personalised and more memorable. Operational excellence is essential, both before and during the stay, especially for families whose needs can be complex. This is why we continue to invest in advisor training and test new tools, such as AI-assisted call analysis, to further enhance the client relationship.

Direct sales play a major role in your business. How are you supporting their growth?

Today, more than 60% of our stays are booked directly, through our call centre or our website. In early 2026, we will launch a new website designed to simplify the customer journey, with more intuitive navigation, a more efficient search engine and improved accessibility. Digital performance is key, but it goes hand in hand with human support: our France-based advisors know our destinations inside out and guide guests from start to finish.

How does brand strategy translate into the on-site experience?

The MMV label truly comes to life in our resorts. We ensure immediate brand recognition, while preserving the identity of each destination. Signature elements such as curiosity walls or climbing walls are rolled out across the portfolio, alongside ongoing renovation programmes — from the Val Thorens restaurant to the Bergers rooms in Alpe d'Huez, and the major Plagne 2000 project, reopening in 2027.

You now also market the Terrésens residences. What does this bring to the offer?

We now handle the marketing and sales of 11 Terrésens properties, including two new openings this winter in Champagne and Saint-Gervais. This partnership enriches our range with premium addresses offering concierge services. It also allows us to propose exceptional properties, notably in Megève and Peisey-Vallandry, with large apartments up to 250 m², private spas and dedicated ski rooms.

Any highlights to watch for this winter?

This winter marks the opening of the new Résidence Club Serra Neva in Serre Chevalier. With 170 apartments, kids' clubs, a pool and a spa, it fully reflects our CSR commitments: HQE high-performance certification, BiodiverCity label, green roof, wood-pellet boiler and solar panels. Like most of our properties, it will also be Green Key certified. We are also enhancing the travel experience with new solutions such as the Travelski Night Express, developed by La Compagnie des Alpes: depart on Friday evening, ski on Saturday morning — with the first day of skiing included in a 6-day MMV lift pass.

At MMV, our resorts blend naturally into the mountain landscape, with façades of wood and stone that feel right at home. Step inside, though, and forget the idea of a stern Alpine chalet. Cuisine That Speaks the Truth

This evolution starts where it matters most: in the kitchen, alongside our teams. Last winter, Cédric Campanella, Head Chef of Le 59, set the tone with a bold, plant-based menu full of colour and creativity. Seven inventive starters took centre stage, including a goat's cheese and mushroom ravioli prepared live in a show-cooking format. Food cooked in front of guests, shared in the moment, creating a real connection between those who cook and those who taste. A joyful, delicious way to spark curiosity... and gently change habits, one plate at a time.



Less Waste, More Common Sense

Since last winter, MMV has been collaborating with Atypique, a specialist in imperfect fruits and vegetables. The result: over 17 tonnes of these slightly blemished but delicious products were cooked across 10 sites in the network.

Atypique testifies:

«The partnership between Atypique and MMV represents a strong commitment to fighting food waste. By incorporating imperfect products into their offerings, MMV is taking concrete action for more responsible food, reducing waste at the source, and ensuring fair compensation for French producers. A sustainable and inspiring approach, embraced with conviction by the entire network!»



CUISINE WITH FLAVOR... AND MEANING

At MMV, hospitality doesn't stop at the reception desk — it extends to the plate. Across our 10 Villages Clubs, guests enjoy half-board or full-board dining, representing nearly one million meals served each season. Plenty of moments, then, to bring together holidays, pleasure... and commitment.

«The shift toward more sustainable food is well underway,» explains Christophe Macina, Purchasing Director. «This winter, 40% of our products will be organic, local, or certified. The goal is clear: reach 80% within five years.»

This eco-responsible approach is also reflected in menus that highlight seasonal and local products, offering healthier cuisine that respects both the planet and local producers.

Trained at the Château de Candie in Chambéry (a Michelin-starred restaurant from 2005 to 2009), Cédric Campanella developed his vision of the profession by working in nearly every role within hospitality and catering. Since 2013, Cédric has been at the helm of Le 59, a go-to address in Aix-les-Bains for discerning palates.

Since 2017, Cédric Campanella has been working closely with MMV, contributing to the training of our chefs, the creation of our menus, and the design and rollout of Signature dishes across our resorts.

What Does This Change, in Practice?

Each year, nearly one million meals are served in our Villages Clubs, making food our second-largest source of emissions after transport.

At MMV, we've chosen to turn the plate into a lever for positive change — supporting local economies, helping regenerate ecosystems, and caring for our guests' health and enjoyment. From responsible sourcing to composting and organic waste recovery, every detail counts.

FOCUS ON ORGANIC AND LOCAL



At MMV, the mountain experience extends to the plate!

For Christophe Macina, Purchasing and Catering Director, combining pleasure and responsibility is never a compromise — it's a mindset. His guiding idea? Source more organic, local and farm-fresh products, and bring them straight to the table... even at 1,800 metres above sea level. Among his trusted partners is Bio d'Ici, a cooperative based in Chambéry. Thanks to this collaboration, eggs, farm yoghurts and apple compotes already feature on the menus of our Villages Clubs, with more seasonal vegetables soon to follow, including potatoes, carrots and onions. Good food, well sourced, and shared at altitude, proof that commitment can also taste great.
